3. **Questions: what does EMC have in terms of characteristics? Why does EMC need their own area plan?**
4. **Discussion followed**
5. **Bruce Parker presented Area plan from citizens group: Presented 4 basic points.**
 - a) They believe we need a very detailed land use plan for this area
 - b) Whatever plan is adopted should be controlled (consistency with decision making)
 - c) List what is unique about community, enliven and bring people to the table for discussion (debate to the table)

The citizen's group doesn't care where the area plan is placed in the general plan, as long as it's meaningful. They believe that this is the start of some solid plans for our area.
