

MINUTES

EAST MILLCREEK COMMUNITY COUNCIL Thursday, September 1, 2005

Members present: Kurt Zimmerman, Judd Jones, Craig Beck, Robin Bennion, Stewart Woodruff and Jay Griffith.

Members Excused: John Rideout, and Richard Lee.

The meeting was called to order by Jay Griffith.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Kurt Zimmerman.

Kurt Zimmerman -- financial report indicated a balance of \$3,349.01.

Deputy Mike Cupello -- Not present.

Message from Mayor Corroon's Office -- Ann Ober - The financial report for 2006 is due now and copy of the request was sent to Richard Lee. The Community Council members are covered by the County Liability Insurance.

County Councilman Mark Crockett -- scheduled a meeting on proposed August 2005 Code changes to the County Zoning Ordinance for September 14 at 7:00 pm in the County Council offices.

Romero Galloway -- Home Depot addition -- John Andresen indicated the proposal to add an open to Enclosure with dimensions of 12" by 96" height of 10" to be located in the north parking lot of the existing store. Eleven parking places will be eliminated but will not change the minimum necessary number of parking place required by ordinance. No vote was taken due to lack of a quorum.

Craig Beck -- Association of Community Councils Together (ACCT) Craig Beck

1. Holladay City annexation several years ago has generated questions about the viability of the Townships. Mayor Corroon is studying this issue.
2. Mayor Corroon will be hold a quarterly Breakfast Meeting in the near future.
3. Lobbying in behalf of the Community Councils at the upcoming Legislature will be a priority. Stewart Woodruff volunteered to represent our Community Council.
4. Next ACCT Meeting will be on September 14 and 7:00 pm

Report on Wasatch Jr. High -- Craig Beck -- the Granite School District will hold a meeting to discuss this issue on November 15 and is not taking input.

Report on Zoning Changes -- Judd Jones and Rita Lund CR -- Judd reviewed the changes and indicated the section allow the Planning Department to make sole decision on simple issues circumvent the Planning Commission and is not acceptable to our Committee Council. Other comments were included in an email to the Planning Department. A recommendation was made by Craig Beck that the Council devout a meeting to the proposed County Zoning Changes.

Township Days Canyon Rim -- Craig Beck -- Ann Ober indicated that Salt Lake County funding is available for special projects but the amount has not been determined. Canyon Rim is planning a Township Day in June 2006 at Cottonwood Park. A recommendation was to offer to have a day prior to December 2005. No final decision was made.

Robin Bennion – Millcreek Township General Plan – A draft copy dated August 2005 is available from Robin. The next meeting of Millcreek Township General Plan committee is scheduled on September 19.

Feedback on the Community Council newsletter – Jeff Griffith and Kurt Zimmerman both indicated very positive comments from neighbors and friends on the newsletter. Robin's daughter will write the article for the next newsletter on the history of the Mill Creek Community Councils. The present cost for the contract for one year will be \$1,536.90.

Report on the Evergreen Avenue sidewalk – Jeff Griffith – this project is years in the making, but the project between 27th and 23rd East is presently underway. The sidewalks will be complete along with the water system upgrade.

Lion International – Bob Gallager – indicated he wanted the Council to know about projects that the Lion's Club sponsors such as the Community Song Fest, Lion's Breakfast on July 4 and providing new eye glasses to people with eye problems.
